

Pool is open 12:00pm to 8:00pm daily

Pool Admission Rules

1. Children who are thirteen (13) years of age or older may enter the pool area without a parent or guardian.
2. Resident children who are twelve (12) years of age or younger will not be admitted into the pool area unless accompanied by:
 - a. The child's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) or sibling thirteen (13) years of age or older.
 - b. A babysitter who is thirteen (13) years of age or older and who has written permission to escort the child into the pool area from the child's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and the sitters parent or guardian.

Babysitters are responsible for the children in their care and are to remain with the children at all times.

Lifeguards are not babysitters!!!

- c. An individual who is eighteen (18) years of age or older and who accepts responsibility for the child and who remains with the child at all times.
3. All members of the community and their guests must sign the guest book and pay the guest fee upon entry to the pool area.
4. All members of the community must have their pool passes with them whenever entering the pool area.
5. Residents who have lost their rights will not be permitted to use the pool or other recreational facilities. **Please note that homeowners whose rights have been rescinded may not use the pool as a guest.**
6.
 - a. All guests (except as noted in 2b) must be accompanied at all times when they are in the pool area by a resident of Sunnybrook who is eighteen (18) years of age or older.
 - b. No more than 5 school age children will be allowed per resident.
 - c. No more than 10 guests total will be allowed per resident.
Any number of guests over this constitutes a Pool Party.

7. A fee of \$2.00 per day will be charged for each guest of a household.
8. All guests, whether dressed for swimming or not, who enter the enclosed pool area, for whatever reason and for whatever length of time, are expected to pay the guest fee of \$2.00 per day per guest.
9. Guests will be subject to all the rules of the Sunnybrook Association, Inc. which governs the use of the swimming and wading pools and the pool area.
10. Residents are responsible for the conduct of their guests while in the pool area.
11. Residents must exercise discretion and common sense in inviting guests to use the pool, especially during peak weekend and holiday periods.

Pool Parties

Pool parties are allowed outside regular swim hours. The hours will be from 9:00am-12:00pm and 8:00 pm until 11:00 pm.

All Pool Parties are restricted to the Pool Deck and Recreation Room Only.

All Pool Parties are to be scheduled at least 2 weeks in advance with the Booking Agent.

There will be a \$200.00 fee for all Pool Parties plus a \$100.00 deposit.

Children's Pool Parties will be allowed during regular operating hours on week days only with a maximum number of 30 participants.

Pool Safety Rules

1. **There will be no swimming permitted without a lifeguard on duty.**
2. Inflated tubes, toys, flippers, web feet or other such paraphernalia are not allowed in the pool except with the express permission of the Sunnybrook Board/lifeguards.
3. No metal or rigid plastic toys or other such objects shall be allowed in either swimming or wading pools.
4. The use of the wading pool shall be limited to children who are five (5) years of age or younger. Please keep in mind that even though the lifeguards are responsible for children using the wading pool, the parent or guardian is also responsible for attending to the child while using the wading pool.
5. Admission to the deep end of the swimming pool shall be limited to individuals who can exhibit to the satisfaction of the lifeguard that they can:
 - a. swim continuously for thirty (30) yards employing a strong stroke kick and overhand stroke, and then can
 - b. immediately tread water for one (1) minute.

Final approval remains, however, within the discretion of the lifeguards.

The lifeguards may waive the aforementioned exhibition of swimming ability for individuals who are sixteen (16) years of age or older and who are, in the opinion of the lifeguards, able to maintain their own safety in the water under normal circumstances.

6. **Diving from the side of the pool is prohibited.** Infraction of this rule could result in expulsion from the pool.
7. Each child must be supervised by his or her parent or guardian while using the wading pool.

Pool Health Rules

1. (*) Any person having any skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharge, or any communicable disease must be excluded from the pool
2. (*) Persons having open blisters, cuts, abrasions, etc. are hereby warned that these may become infected and are advised not to use the pool.
3. (*) Spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose in the pool or in any way contaminating the pool is prohibited.
4. (*) No running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, disruptive activity or any kind, or causing undue disturbance, is allowed in or about the pool area.
5. (*) Persons not dressed for bathing shall not be allowed on the walks immediately adjacent to the swimming pool (e.g., the immediate edge of the pool)
6. Before entering the pool, at the discretion of the lifeguards, all persons must remove oils, dirt and sand from their bodies by use of the shower facilities provided.
7. No pets are permitted in the pool area at any time.
- 8. No Smoking is permitted in the pool area and within 10 feet from the outside of the pool fence.**
9. If your child is in diapers, they **MUST** have a pair of plastic or rubber pants over the diaper when in the water.
Please keep a close eye on your child when in the Kiddy Pool, the lifeguard is there for safety reasons; not as a baby-sitter.

Pool Food and Beverage Rules

1. All refuse will be deposited in appropriate containers.
2. Food may be consumed within the pool area, but is not permitted within four (4) feet of the water.
3. Beverages are permitted in the pool area; but must not be consumed from glass containers and must not be consumed within four (4) feet of the water
4. Discretion must be exercised when consuming alcoholic beverages at poolside. Unseemly conduct and abusive language will not be tolerated.
